

Rehoboth Community Garden

Rules and Regulations

- I will pay a membership fee of \$30 for a full plot for one year. (Option to rent up to 3 plots per year at \$30 a plot.)
- I will have something planted in my garden by June 15th. If I do not, I understand that I automatically forfeit my plot.
- I will respect the gardening hours established by the garden coordinator. No gardening on Sundays. (Monday-Saturday only).
- I will respect the surrounding residential neighbours.
- If I must abandon my plot for any reason, I will notify the garden coordinators.
- I will keep weeds down and maintain the areas immediately surrounding my plot.
- If my plot becomes unkempt, I understand that I will be given two weeks notice to clean it up. After that time, it will be reassigned or tilled.
- I will clean up litter any time I see it on or near Rehoboth United Reformed Church.
- I will plant tall crops only where they do not shade neighbouring plots.
- I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by another plot's gardener.
- I will limit use of synthetic fertilizers, pesticides, and weed repellent as much as possible. I understand that I can add my own compost and topsoil as needed.
- I will ensure the gate is latched behind me every time. (New in 2026: There will not be a lock on the gate, but please ensure the gate is still closed and latch when you leave.)
- I will pay my renewal fee by October 31st for the next season if I wish to renew. If I miss the deadline, I understand that I may lose my plot and will have to go on the waitlist for an available plot.
- I understand that I am responsible for myself and my guest, as outlined in the garden waiver included with my registration.
